EXERCISE VIRTUAL COURT APPEARANCES

Background

You're on a litigation team defending your client against an employment discrimination claim. A discovery dispute has arisen, and a hearing on your client's motion to compel has been set for next week. The judge is holding it remotely because most of the parties are out of state.

The partner on the case asked you to handle the appearance. You'll be the only person on your team speaking at the appearance. This will be your first time doing a remote appearance in this court.
